### FROM THE NORTH:

Take 71 S. to 670 W; Take immediate 3rd St. Exit to left; Take 3rd St. to Whittier St.; Turn Right on Whittier; Turn Left at S. High St. Maennerchor will be on Left.

### FROM THE SOUTH

Take 71N to exit 105 (Greenlawn Ave.); Turn Right at Greenlawn Ave.; Turn Left at S. Front St.; Take 3rd Right onto Frederick St.; Turn Right onto High St. Maennerchor will be on the Left.

### FROM THE EAST

Take Rte. 33 E / Livingston Ave W; Turn Left at S. Ohio Ave.; Turn Right at Thurman Ave.; Turn Sharp Right onto S. High St. Maennerchor will be on Left.

### FROM THE WEST

Take 70 E to exit 100A/(S. Front St.); Merge onto W. Fulton St.; Continue onto W. Livingston Ave.; Turn Right at S. High St. Maennerchor will be on the Left.
